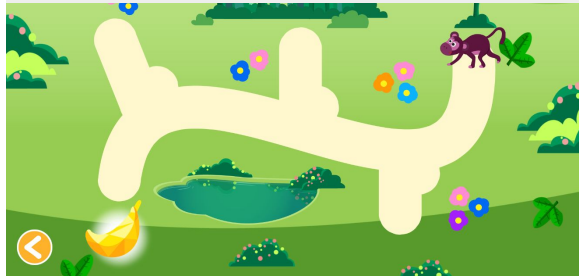
Learning objectives
