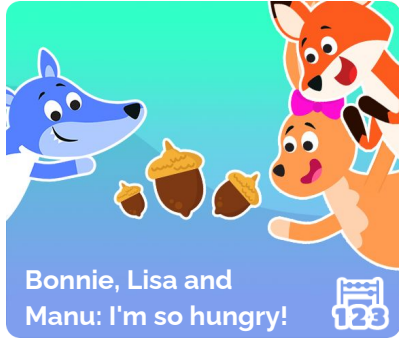

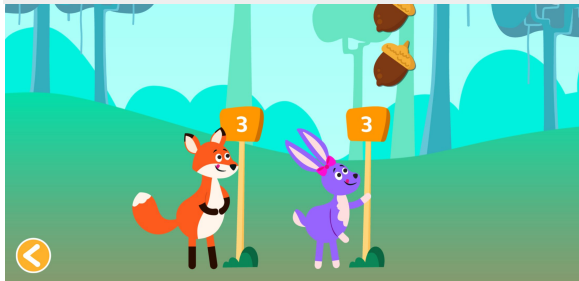
Difficulty of game



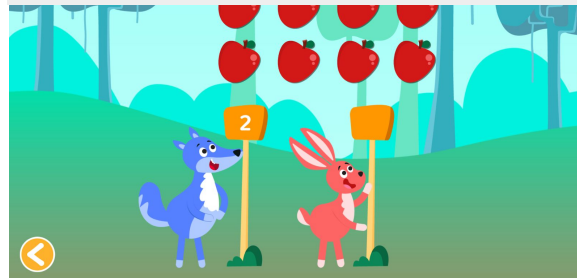
Learning objectives
