4. Do you know what a set is?

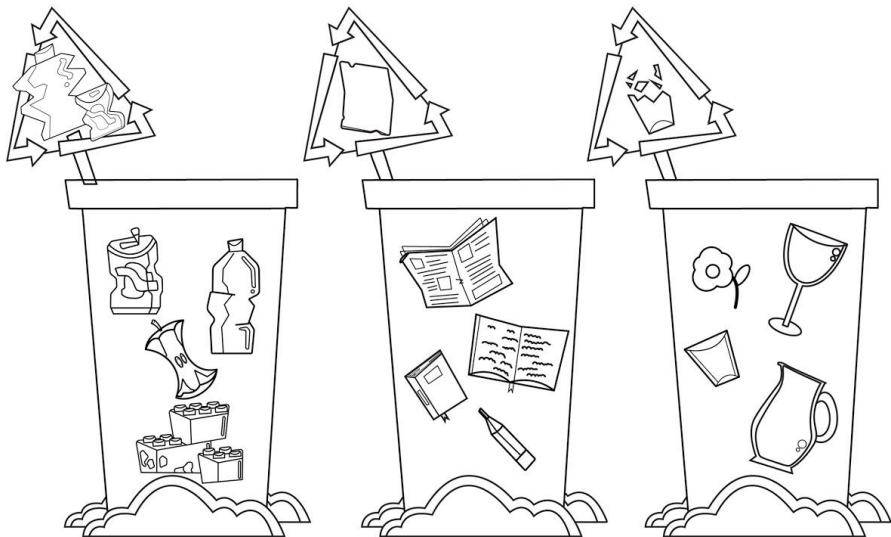
Ideas for activities
